

SMART GOAL #2:

100% of students will participate in regular formative assessments with the purpose of demonstrating quantifiable progress and improvement with course standards.



1. Teaching staff will participate in Mastery Connect training to support technology integrations in the classroom.
2. Departmental data meetings will be held throughout the year to analyze common assessment data and develop action plans to address areas in need of improvement.
3. Teaching staff will utilize MasteryConnect for formative and common assessment data collection.



1. 100% of teaching staff will participate in MasteryConnect training to support technology integration in the classroom.
2. Four departmental data meetings will occur throughout the year for staff to analyze common assessment data and develop action plans to address areas in need of improvement.
3. 100% of teaching staff will utilize MasteryConnect for formative and common assessment data collection.

ACTION STEPS

1. Staff will establish PLCs for the purpose of improving instruction in classrooms, building collegiality with their peers and to provide the autonomy for selecting relevant and meaningful professional development related to their course content.
2. Staff will review 2016 student exit survey results with Department Chairs, School Council, PAC and Full Staff to help develop future advisory topics and assemblies.
3. Principal's Advisory Committee will continue to solicit feedback from staff and students of areas that need attention and/or improvement.
4. Staff will implement Advisor/Advisee program that will help foster positive relationships with students.

BENCHMARKS

1. 100% of teaching staff will participate in professional learning community that is focused on school SMART goals and learning expectations.
2. 2016 student exit surveys will be shared with staff to help develop future Advisory topics and school assemblies.
3. Principal's Advisory Committee will meet monthly to discuss areas that need attention and/or improvement. This information will be shared out to the full staff.
4. Advisory periods will take place between 8 to 10 times during the school year giving students the opportunity to discuss relevant adolescent topics.
